



## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## RAISING FOR STORAGE / TRANSPORTATION:


- 1. APPLY BRAKES ON CASTERS
- 2. HAVE 2 PEOPLE MINIMUM LIFT FIRST ROW OF BLEACHER AND RAISE IT UNTIL BOTH CASTERS ARE ON THE FLOOR
- 3. RELEASE BRAKES PRIOR TO TRANSPORTING
- 4. USE 2 PEOPLE FOR TRANSPORTING THE BLEACHER
- 5. ALWAYS APPLY BRAKES WHILE BLEACHER IS STORED

## LOWERING FOR USE

- 1. APPLY BRAKES ON CASTERS
- 2. HAVE 2 PEOPLE MINIMUM LOWER THE BLEACHER SO THAT ALL RUBBER FOOT PADS MAKE CONTACT WITH THE FLOOR

## GENERAL NOTES:

- DO NOT USE OR TRANSPORT BLEACHER ON UNEVEN SURFACE DO NOT TRANSPORT BLEACHER DURING WINDY CONDITIONS
- BLEACHER ONLY TO BE TRANSPORTED BY QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS
